ORDER:

As per the Notification of the Council of Architecture (CoA), New Delhi second read above, orders were issued for revised eligibility for B.Arch degree course from the year 2019-20 as detailed below in the Government Order fourth read above:-

“No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, chemistry & Mathematics and also at least 50% marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate.”

2. The Commissioner of Technical Education in the letters fifth read above, has stated that in the circular dated 7.8.2018 from the Council of Architecture, New Delhi regarding eligibility for admission to B.Arch. degree course during 2018-19, it is stated that the Institutions shall follow the reservation policy of respective Government in granting relaxation in percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying examination for admission purposes. The eligibility of admission to first year B.Arch. degree programmes for the academic year 2018-19 was followed as per the minutes of first meeting of Co-ordination Committee for TNEA 2018 and TANCA 2018 held on 23.3.2018 at Anna University as detailed below:-

Qualifying Examination and Eligibility followed in 2018-19:

**a) HSC (Academic)/ Equivalent**

Candidates who have passed 10+2 or its equivalent examination with Mathematics / Business Mathematics as one of the subjects.

Candidates who have passed 10+2 or its equivalent examination with atleast the following minimum aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics and also at least Minimum aggregate mark in all the subjects put together category wise.

3. The Professor and Dean, School of Architecture and Planning, Anna University / nominee of Government of Tamil Nadu to Council of Architecture,

New Delhi in her letter sixth read above, has obtained clarification from the Registrar, Council of Architecture, New Delhi and clarified that as per the Minimum Standards of Architectural Education 2017, prescribed by the Council of Architecture, the reservation of seats and the relaxation in percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying examination for admission into 1<sup>st</sup> year of 5-year B.Arch course shall be as per the reservation policy of the Central Government or the respective State Governments.

4. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Technical Education in para 2 above based on the clarification of Council of Architecture, New Delhi and accordingly,

- i) Ratify the action of TNEA 2018 for following the norms for minimum eligibility marks for admission to B.Arch. degree course based on the minutes of meeting of Co-ordination Committee constituted for TNEA 2018 held on 23.3.2018 at Anna University without orders from the Government for the year 2018-19.
- ii) Direct as detailed below for fixation of minimum eligibility percentage of marks for admission to first year of five years B.Arch. degree course from the academic year 2019-20 in Engineering Colleges in Tamil Nadu:
